Calcutta Girls' College offers the following programs:

1. Literature & Languages Study (Urdu, Hindi, English & Bengali) under B.A. Hons & Gen
2. Social Sciences (History, Political Science, Education, Economics) under B.A. Hons & Gen
3. Science (Mathematics and Economics) under B.Sc General

Each program is designed and the curriculum taught in such a way to encourage pursuit of higher studies and preparation for jobs associated with the particular course. Students have entered into professions related to academics, software support, hospitality, art and culture, legal consultation, management, government jobs. There are several new career options to be tapped under the present CBCS.

Career Counselling Cell undertakes regular programmes and awareness exercises to keep the students updated about the various options both in the job market and in fields of higher education. Students are introduced to the further studies options that can lead to research, rewarding career options and activities that enrich society like Journalism, Film studies, Women's Studies, Mass Communication, M.B.A., Chartered Accountancy, Defence Studies, Law etc.

Course Outcomes

➤ Literature & Languages Study (Urdu, Hindi, English & Bengali) under B.A. Hons & Gen

Department of Bengali runs Undergraduate Courses in Bengali under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). As per the syllabus of the courses, approved by the University of Calcutta, they offer both core courses and general elective courses and also ability enhancement compulsory course (AECC) as compulsory to all the undergraduate students of the college. If undertaken, the students of Bengali language and literature will acquire the knowledge of Bengali grammar, history of Bengali literature and cultural history of the Bengal through various texts. In the syllabi special importance has also been given on expertise development with skill enhancement courses (SEC). Such Emphasis will definitely increase the possibility of success of the outgoing students in media, script writing, teaching, theatre, recitation, cinema and other sectors in future.

Department of English offers Core, DSE, AECC and SEC courses in English under CBCS, as per the syllabi approved by the University of Calcutta. Along with traditional courses, students are initiated into courses that **diversify interests and open up career scopes in diverse professions**. Students of this department have made their mark in various fields ranging from teaching, legal consultation agency, hospitality industry, front-desk jobs, aviation, content writing, translator both within and outside the country.

The present CBCS syllabus has further widened the horizon in terms of choices in higher education, career options and self-developments

- a. A course in CC6 Popular Literature introduces to comics, children's literature and detective fiction. It also opens up lesser explored but rewarding career avenues of comic book artist
- b. CC11: Women's Writings and DSE B2 CONTEMPORARY INDIA: WOMEN AND EMPOWERMENT initiate the students in feminism and prepares them for the Women's Studies that ensures position in college teaching, future research and writing
- c. DSE-A4 –MEDIA AND COMMUNICATION STUDIES opens up the future profession in media, both before and behind the camera
- d. SEC-B1 – CREATIVE WRITING lays the basic groundwork for aspiring writers in various modes and medium

हिन्दी विभाग, कलकत्ता गर्ल्स कॉलेज

The **Department of Urdu** began its journey with the establishment of General department in the year 1963. With time it gained its due popularity and importance and finally in the year 2001 the college started providing Honours course. It has always been the sole agenda of the department to enhance the quality of the standards of the students and the department takes immense pride in having some of the most dedicated and enthusiastic teachers. Universities, Colleges , primary and higher secondary education field. The students who have graduated from our college has found enough career opportunities with esteemed and noble profession in various fields. As journalists, writers, poets in electronic media and print media sphere; such as Akashwani, All India Radio, Doordarshan and ETV Urdu. And are contributing to the betterment of society as teachers in Universities, Colleges , primary and higher secondary education field. With the recent reformed syllabus introduced as CBCS by Calcutta University it has opened new arenas and enhanced scope for a bright future of the students of this language. With the inclusion of advanced and modern papers on Film, theater and radio the students have found new interests. The department has taken an initiative in training their students that will benefit them in near future in the field of theater and film as well.

➤ **Social Sciences (History, Political Science, Education, Economics) under B.A. Hons & Gen**

The Department of History is one of the constituent Departments of Calcutta Girls College. Ever since the inception of the college in the year 1963, the Department of History is working hard to impart productive knowledge in the discipline. The Honours Department started in the year 1998. It is one of the largest departments of the college with at present five faculty members specializing in different fields of History. The Department of History runs Undergraduate Courses in History under the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS). As per the syllabus approved by the University of Calcutta, they offer both Core Courses and Generic Elective Courses. The syllabus begins with human evolution and development of world civilization. It gives emphasis on the political, economic, socio-cultural and religious history of ancient, medieval and modern periods of the sub-continent, thereby enriching the students on the variegated mechanism and methodologies for the study of history. Select readings on World History is also a part of the syllabus. The syllabus also gives emphasis on Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) widening the area of knowledge of the students in related fields of Archaeology, Museology, Heritage Management and Art Appreciation. On the whole, the programme is set to envision and practice the making of knowledge about the rich cultural heritage of our nation and renders a wide scope in different areas of research work. Moreover, the course aims at job opportunities as teachers in schools, colleges and universities and official jobs in different Heritage Institutions, Museums and Archaeological Surveys, of course, besides more regular avenues.

The **Department of Political Science** offers Undergraduate course in Political Science under the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS), approved by the University of Calcutta, both Core Courses and General Elective Courses. The syllabi of the courses have been compiled in such a manner that the students develop comprehensive understanding of the subject and opens different domain of political theory and philosophy, Indian politics, comparative politics, public administration and international politics. The interdisciplinary nature of the course helps student for better understanding of political, social and economic issues and challenges. The students

passing out with such comprehensive course gets a platform to sustain in any field like administrative, academic etc.

The **Department of Economics** department offers BSc Honours in Economics and Generic Elective (GE) courses under the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS). The syllabus is designed by the University of Calcutta. The honours course builds on the foundation provided by the Core Courses (CC) that impart in depth theoretical and descriptive understanding of the subject. These courses are designed to train the students in a scientific and logical fundamentals that help to analyse and understand the economic institutions and activities. The programme also lets the students choose elective courses (DSE) that focuses on currently relevant topics as per their own interest. this helps them to prepare for future endeavours. Besides, the programme also offer Skill enhancement courses that allow them to acquire desirable skills like data analysis, research methodology etc. Overall this course is a great option for students interested in social sciences as this course trains them in both very technical/mathematical abstract theories on one hand and discusses contemporary economic issues faced by our country and the world. This programme trains them to be able to choose from plethora of future career options like academics, corporate jobs, analytics, law, management, government services etc.

The **Department of Education** runs Undergraduate Honours and General Courses under the Choice-Based Credit System (CBCS) introduced in 2018-19 session. In the syllabi a special importance has also been given on expertise development with Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC) and Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course. Learning outcomes include expertise in sociological, philosophical, psychological foundations of education, understanding of educational organization, management and planning, proficiency in guidance and counselling, learning about the use of technology in education, basic knowledge of educational research and knowledge of inclusive education. They also become familiar with concepts of human rights education, knowledge regarding educational thought of great educators, teacher education and also concept of gender and society. There is also a special stress on women education and empowerment. There is vast scope for students of this discipline, but it needs hard work and patience. Students can appear for UPSC civil services, other competitive exams, can look for job opportunities in law, IT, banking sectors or opt for further higher education and research or join NGOs. They may also seek jobs in career guidance, education psychology, market and policy research, publishing houses, media, etc. Some of the subject specific job positions are----

community education officer, education administrator, therapists, teaching assistants, museum education officer, career advisors, public relation journalists, etc. The students can have a profound effect on community and society as they are specially trained in life skills. After passing their UG and PG they would be able to apply for teaching jobs in schools, colleges and universities too.

Department of Mathematics was established as an Under Graduate Department in 1963 with General streams. The department runs only undergraduate course in Mathematics under the choice based credit system (CBCS) and follow Calcutta University approved syllabus. The department only provides General elective course in Mathematics. The department has two efficient and highly qualified permanent faculty members. The teachers did their best to develop mathematical skills of the students of this department. The department also provides interactive classroom teaching. Students are encouraged to do classroom exercises in a group, through productive discussions. Weaker students receive special attention in the form of special one-on-one teaching, tutorial classes etc. Also the students of this department actively consult the teachers time to time for solving their problems and thinking new idea about Mathematics.
